# WELCOME TO YOUR MZD CONNECT GUIDE

Inside you'll find everything you need to know about Mazda's in-car connectivity, including Sat Nav, Bluetooth® connecting with your favourite music and more. MZD Connect is easy to use and is designed to make your driving experience as enjoyable and safe as possible.

# PAIRING YOUR PHONE



For many features, you must use a smartphone that is compatible and paired to the system. To check compatibility visit [mazda.com.au/owners/help-and-support/pair-your-phone](http://mazda.com.au/owners/help-and-support/pair-your-phone). Once you see your device is compatible, follow the instructions below to pair your phone. For more detailed information, please refer to your Owner's Manual.

## Pair (or add) a device

- 1 Ensure your phone's Bluetooth® is ON and it is in discovery mode.
- 2 Select 'COMMUNICATION' from the Home Screen.

## For first time pairing

- 3 If pairing for the first time, the handsfree system will notify you that no phones are connected and ask if you would like to connect a phone now. Select 'CONNECT.' Continue from instruction 5.

## For subsequent pairings

- 3 Select 'SETTINGS' from the Communication menu.
- 4 Select 'BLUETOOTH®' from the Settings menu.
- 5 Ensure Bluetooth® is ON, and then select 'ADD NEW DEVICE.'
- 6 The system will prompt you to search for MAZDA in your Bluetooth® device. Begin the pairing process on the phone. You may be asked to verify and acknowledge a 6 digit code on both the handset and system during the pairing process.

Please note:

- Before pairing your device, be sure that Bluetooth® has been turned on in your vehicle and on your device.
- When updating the operating system of your mobile device (such as Windows/Android/iOS), pairing information may be invalidated. If this occurs, delete/remove pairing from both the device and system and follow the pairing procedure to add it again.
- You cannot pair your phone using voice recognition.
- Instructions may vary, depending on your system's version of software.

# CALLS, TEXTS AND EMAILS



Your work, family and friends can be with you wherever you go when you use your infotainment system to keep your world within easy reach.

## Making and receiving a call

To accept:

- 1 Press the CALL PICKUP button on steering wheel.

To dial: Press the TALK button, wait for the beep, then say:

- 1 'CALL' or 'DIAL'.
- 2 'CALL' or 'DIAL' + the person's name you want to call.

## Text messaging and email

Display notification of received SMS/email messages:

- 1 Select 'COMMUNICATION' from Home Screen.
- 2 Select 'SETTINGS'.

- 3 Switch Email/SMS notification to ON; to turn notification off, switch to OFF.
- 4 Switch Auto Download Email or Auto Download Text (SMS/MMS) to ON; to turn automatic downloading off, switch to OFF.

## Download and view messages manually from your connected device

- 1 Select 'SMS' or 'EMAIL' from the Communication menu.
- 2 Select 'UPDATE INBOX' (email) or 'UPDATE MESSAGES' (SMS); download from connected mobile phone will begin.
- 3 Select message from list.

Please note:

- Notifications within Bluetooth® settings on your phone must be switched to 'ON' for text messaging and email functionality.
- Additionally, when driving, the system will only read the message to you. You will not be able to view the message.

## ENTERTAINMENT

Music, news, sports, podcasts or talk radio – it's all right here, easily accessible for your listening pleasure and convenience.



### **Bluetooth®**

Bluetooth® Audio means you can access audio content on your smartphone or portable audio player in your vehicle via Bluetooth.®

#### **Radio (DAB+)**

Selected Mazda models feature DAB+ digital radio technology, providing you with more stations, clearer reception and improved sound quality. Add your preferred DAB+, AM or FM radio stations to your Favourites list for easy access via the multi-function commander. Radio Data Systems (RDS) program information such as station name, track name and artist is available if the radio station transmits it.

#### **AUX (auxiliary jack) and USB mode**

Listen to your iPod or other compatible audio players through your car's speakers by connecting to the 3.5mm AUX input or via USB.

Playable data includes: MP3/WMA/AAC/OGG files (applies to USB only). Compatibility will vary according to your device.

#### **Bose® audio**

Selected Mazda models feature a premium Bose® audio sound system to enhance audio sensation in your car. Bose® Centerpoint® converts stereo signals to multiple channels to give a surround sound effect. Bose® AudioPilot® monitors noise levels in the cabin, adjusting specific frequencies to compensate for background noise and vehicle speed.

# NAVIGATION (SELECTED MODELS ONLY)



Whether you're taking a family holiday or travelling for business, your vehicle's navigation system will help you arrive easily at any destination.

## Settings

Using navigation is simple and convenient when you take the time to configure the system to your preferences. Some of the MZD Connect features that can be personalised are listed below.

### Map settings:

Change colour themes for both day and night use; selecting which places should appear on map; choice of 3D perspective or top-down view; and showing or suppressing 3D city models, 3D artistic or block representation of full city building data.

### Guidance settings:

Adjust how the software uses various route-related information on the map screen.

### Warning settings:

Activate specific warnings and alerts; adjust volume; set up warnings related to speed limit and monitoring current speed; set notifications of road safety cameras and other proximity alert points.

### Traffic settings:

Enable or disable use of traffic or detour information.

### Route settings:

Change route type; options include FAST, SHORT, ECONOMICAL and EASY.

### Getting started

To ensure correct operation of the Voice Recognition functions within Navigation please follow these instructions:

- ① Select 'SETTINGS' from Home Screen.
- ② Select the 'SYSTEM' tab.
- ③ Select 'LANGUAGE' from System menu.
- ④ Select your chosen language.

### Find help

Use the preset search features to find the emergency services you need in any location. These locations can also be saved to your Favourites.

### Destinations

It's easy to find the right destination when you have a variety of convenient options. Choose a place of interest, a location on the map, one of your Favourites, a destination from your history, or enter an address or co-ordinates.

### Update my maps

Two free map updates per year for three years are provided (from purchase date) to ensure you always have the most up-to-date and accurate maps.

- Sound – bass, treble, fade etc
- Clock – adjust time, daylight savings etc
- Vehicle – door locks and turn indicator and lighting
- Devices – Bluetooth® and network (Wi-Fi)
- System – language, temperature, distance restore and music database update
