

BT-50 GRASS ACCUMULATION RECALL CLEANING PROCEDURE



A STEP BY STEP GUIDE



PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

To avoid injury ensure that you are wearing the correct Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) before commencing the cleaning procedure described below.





GETTING STARTED


- 1 Locate an appropriate area that is free from debris and has adequate room to safely move around the vehicle. The procedure must be carried out on a hard level surface.
 - **a.** For <u>Automatic Transmission</u> vehicles: Turn off the ignition, place the transmission selector lever in position P (Park) and securely apply the Parking Brake.
 - **b.** For <u>Manual Transmission</u> vehicles: Turn off the ignition, place the transmission selector in the 1st or reverse position and securely apply the Parking Brake.
- To avoid injury ensure that you wait until the vehicle has cooled down. Mazda recommends waiting for a minimum of 1 hour after the vehicle ignition has been turned off.
- Inspect for any grass / debris accumulation at the point indicated below. To inspect the affected area, you will need to inspect from under the vehicle. Mazda recommends placing a ground sheet down before accessing the underside of the vehicle.

If there are any signs of debris buildup, this will need to be removed.

Removal can be achieved by dislodging the debris by hand.

Note: Please attempt to remove all debris before driving the vehicle.

Note: Once debris is removed, please ensure that you do not continue to drive in high grass areas.
